DOCTOR OF HUMANE

LETTERS ARNAUD CARTWRIGHT MARTS

Pioneer fundraiser and founder of Marts and Lundy. President of Bucknell University and prime nurturer of Bucknell University Junior College. In 1936 he brought Dr. Eugene S. Farley to lead the BUJC campus and served as his senior adviser in raising funds, building the Board of Trustees, and securing family mansions to begin the present Wilkes College campus. For more than three decades he devoted his energies, talents and resources to make this College succeed. Through this posthumous recognition, Wilkes honors a founder.

DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS HELEN FARR SLOAN

Artist, writer, educator, philanthropist. Supporter of artists and scholars studying American realist painters of the early twentieth century, including her husband, John Sloan, co-founder of "The Eight." Builder of collections and exhibitions featuring "The Eight" through financial support and artistic guidance to the Delaware Art Museum and the Sordoni Art Gallery of Wilkes College. By preserving and interpreting the legacy of a group of painters who portrayed everyday American life, she has made art more accessible to the American public, including residents of the Wyoming Valley.

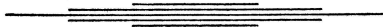

Mace and Chain of Office

The inauguration of President Michelini marked the first ceremonial use of two important insignia given to Wilkes College. The handsome mace and chain of office are the gifts of local donors.

The two insignia were designed by Ottie Hill Chwalek '61 and executed by a nationally known gold and silversmith, Professor Kurt J. Matzdorf of the State University of New York College at New Paltz, New Paltz, New York.

The College Mace

THE MACE is made of sterling silver throughout. At the lower end of the hammered shaft is a gilt (gold-plated) knob. The upper end of the shaft displays the inscription "Wilkes College 1933." Above the short, hammered neck rises a bowl to indicate that Wilkes-Barre acted as a melting pot in forming a new and vigorous community of people of many different backgrounds. This theme is clearly stated in the gilt inscription around the upper part of the bowl: "Unity Amidst Diversity." Set into the top of the bowl is the gilt seal of Wilkes College. The top of the mace is a gilt flame-like structure to indicate the enlightenment to be gained from higher education. A piece of anthracite coal from a local mine is set in the center of this "flame" to commemorate the origin of the community and the College in its coal mining past.

The Chain of Office

THE CHAIN OF OFFICE of the President of Wilkes College is four feet long and is made of sterling silver throughout. The links of the chain are alternating silver bowls and gilt flames repeating the motif of the mace. In the front hangs the gilt seal of Wilkes College suspended from a cluster of oak leaves with three acorns to suggest the strength and sturdiness of future generations. The back of the chain is a silver portrait of Eugene S. Farley, first president of Wilkes College, set in a cluster of gilt oak leaves to commemorate his strong leadership of the College.
