

It is with great pleasure that the Sordoni Art Gallery presents this selection of prints from the collection of two Pennsylvanians, John C. O'Connor and Ralph M. Yeager. Primarily lithographs, these views of Pennsylvanian cities and towns date from the mid-eighteenth century through the late nineteenth. They illustrate not only a visual history of the urban and rural development of the state, but also the evolution of a style mandated by a particular subject matter — that is, the literal, on-site recording of a particular town. Not merely a side-light to the exhibition is the technical process by which these prints were made, first through engraving and later by the more expeditious and versatile method of lithography, which by the midnineteenth century was experiencing something of a heyday.

The earliest work in the exhibition is a rare and very important hand-tinted engraving of Bethlehem by an amateur artist who was a grocer in that city. In this charmingly naive print, the landscape is punctuated with signs of eighteenth century life — a plowhand, farm animals in pasture, and the bucolic patterns made by neatly planted orchards.

Drama evocative of the French Romantics is the primary element in an artist's version of the great Johnstown fire and flood of 1889. Indicative of the scope of the market to fulfill the late nineteenth century appetite for good quality lithographs of historic sites and events, is the fact that this print was published and circulated by the Chicago-based firm of Kurz and Allison.

Similar, therefore, in subject matter only, this selection of prints holds something for the untrained in the arts as well as for the connoisseur. Perhaps most importantly, to quote the art historian Harold Dickson, is that beyond the abundance of antiquarian, sociohistorical, esthetic, art-technical, educational, and curiosity-stirring elements, there is the plain truth that this exhibition is great fun to look at.
