## DOCTOR OF HUMANE

United States Senator from New Jersey. Three-time All-American basketball player at Princeton University. Rhodes Scholar at Oxford University. Ten-year star of the New York Knickerbockers. Personifies the disciplined mind and body, applying his talent and energy to the public's business. Leader rather than follower of public and Congressional opinion, he fathered the comprehensive overhaul of the Federal tax system resulting in the Tax Reform Act of 1986. At present, focusing on Third World debt, he seeks to direct the nation's attention to the dependence of the American economy on Third World customers capable of buying U.S. products. Conceptual, not ideological, practical rather than theoretical, Senator Bradley has applied his disciplined intelligence and passion for excellence to issues of education, children, the elderly, economic development, and the environment, to free and fair trade worldwide, providing intelligent leadership to a self-governing, democratic people.

Internationally recognized Superintendent of Hueneme, California, School District. Graduate of Wilkes College where he made Dean's List and earned eight varsity letters in baseball and football. Received a Master of Arts in Education from Columbia University and a Doctorate in Education from the University of Northern Colorado. Pioneer public school educator in orchestrating the most advanced educational technology to help students learn through teacher-directed individualized instruction. With his colleagues at Hueneme, he has assembled the first "SmartClassroom" to motivate and empower students to prepare for adult roles in the technologically sophisticated twenty-first century. This year he has addressed two international conferences on children and computers. Superintendent Rescigno has inspired teamwork and investment among teachers, parents, business and government leaders to revitalize our public schools and prepare our children for productive, fulfilling lives in the information age.

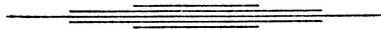

# Mace and Chain of Office

The inauguration of President Michelini marked the first ceremonial use of two important insignia given to Wilkes College. The handsome mace and chain of office are the gifts of local donors.

The two insignia were designed by Ottie Hill Chwalek '61 and executed by a nationally known gold and silversmith, Professor Kurt J. Matzdorf of the State University of New York College at New Paltz, New Paltz, New York.

## *The College Mace*

THE MACE is made of sterling silver throughout. At the lower end of the hammered shaft is a gilt (gold-plated) knob. The upper end of the shaft displays the inscription "Wilkes College 1933." Above the short, hammered neck rises a bowl to indicate that Wilkes-Barre acted as a melting pot in forming a new and vigorous community of people of many different backgrounds. This theme is clearly stated in the gilt inscription around the upper part of the bowl: "Unity Amidst Diversity." Set into the top of the bowl is the gilt seal of Wilkes College. The top of the mace is a gilt flame-like structure to indicate the enlightenment to be gained from higher education. A piece of anthracite coal from a local mine is set in the center of this "flame" to commemorate the origin of the community and the College in its coal mining past.

## *The Chain of Office*

THE CHAIN OF OFFICE of the President of Wilkes College is four feet long and is made of sterling silver throughout. The links of the chain are alternating silver bowls and gilt flames repeating the motif of the mace. In the front hangs the gilt seal of Wilkes College suspended from a cluster of oak leaves with three acorns to suggest the strength and sturdiness of future generations. The back of the chain is a silver portrait of Eugene S. Farley, first President of Wilkes College, set in a cluster of gilt oak leaves to commemorate his strong leadership of the College.
