WAGE AND SALARY SUMMARY

This is the fifth of a continuing series of compilations of wage, salary, and fringe benefit data for third class cities in Luzerne County.

Because specific job descriptions are not a part of this Summary, local government officials in Luzerne County should be careful in making comparisons in pay scales. Public officials should keep in mind the varying degrees of responsibility and authority, along with the diversities in functions and duties, in the various offices, even those with the same titles. The purpose of the Report is merely to present the facts rather than make a judgment on policy.

The salary and wage scales were extracted from the salary ordinances adopted by the third class cities in Luzerne County in December, 1967 for fiscal 1968. The Institute wishes to thank the city clerks in all four cities for making this Survey possible.

The City Treasurer, by virtue of his office, shall be the collector of the city taxes. The salary listed in the table includes both the city's share of his salary as tax collector and his salary as treasurer.

The firemen are volunteers in Hazleton, Nanticoke, and Pittston. The salaries in the table are for the fire truck drivers who are the only full-time paid personnel in these three cities.
